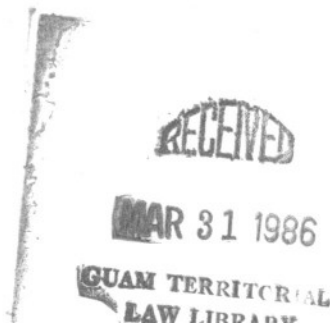

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 345 TO THE PENAL CODE OF
GUAM PROHIBITING THE LITTER OF HIGHWAYS, PARKS, AND
OTHER PUBLIC PLACES.

1 Be it enacted by the people of the territory of Guam, That a
2 new Section 345 is hereby added to the Penal Code of Guam to read as
3 follows:

4 "Section 345. Proscription of Litter in Public Places.

5 (a) No person shall place, dispose, throw, or permit to be
6 deposited or scattered, any waste, refuse, litter, or foreign
7 substance in or upon any highway, street or other public passageway,
8 or upon any beach, or public park, where receptacles have been provided
9 therefor and signs posted by the government of Guam.

10 (b) Violation of this section shall be a misdemeanor punished
11 by a fine not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)."
