AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 4233 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PROVIDE FOR COVERAGE OF MEMBERS OF LEGIS-LATURE IN THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 4233 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 4233. Coverage of members of the Legislature.

- (a) Except as may be otherwise expressly provided in this section, the provisions of this chapter shall apply to any person who has served as a member of the Legislature, or who shall hereafter serve as such a member and any such person shall be entitled to receive an annuity calculated in accordance with Section 4211 of this title and based upon his years of credited services as hereinafter provided.
- (b) For the purposes of this section and of Section 4211 of this title, service as a member of the Legislature during a regular session of any one calendar year shall be deemed a full year of service as a member of the Legislature.
- (c) Any person who has served as a member of the Legislature or who shall hereafter serve as such a member shall be entitled to receive credit as prior service for all services rendered as a member of the Legislature or in any other department, division, or agency of the government of Guam, or U.S. Government, provided, that in order to obtain credit for such prior service as a member of the Legislature, a person shall pay within

- (d) In the case of any person who shall be a member of the Logislature on January 1, 1966 or who shall thereafter become such a member the annual average compensation of such person for the purposes of this chapter shall be considered as Six Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) and the amount of contribution required of such person for the purposes of Section 4218
- (e) No provisions of this chapter or any other Act relating to automatic separation from the service shall be applicable to any member
- (f) As used in this section, the term 'Legislature' means the Guam Legislature created by the Organic Act of Guam. (65 Stat. 393).
- (g) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section, the provisions of this chapter shall not apply to any member of the Legislature until he gives notice in writing, while serving as a member of the Legislature, to the Board of his desire to come within the purview of this chapter. Such notice may be given by a member of the Legislature within twelve months after January 1, 1966 or within twelve months after any date on which he takes an oath of office as a member of the Legislature; provided, that any person who qualifies as a member of the Legislature for service prior to January 1, 1966, but is not such a member on such date shall give notice in writing within twelve months after January 1, 1966, to the Board of his desire to come within the purview of this chapter.
- (h) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this section, the provisions hereof shall not apply to any member of the Legislature who, while serving therein, is already receiving benefits under this chapter as a result of service in any other department, division or agency of the Government of Guam, or U.S. Government."
