AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 15102 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM
RELATING TO THE DUTIES OF THE WASHINGTON REPRESENTATIVE.

1 WHEREAS, under the existing law, it is necessary for Guam's
2 Washington Representative to report in person to the Legislature
3 each year, and

4 WHEREAS, although personal visits by the Washington Representative
5 to the Legislature are important and desirable, it is nevertheless
6 the consensus of the Legislature that no specific month be required
7 for such personal visits so that the Washington Representative may
8 be permitted to stay in Washington during the month of June when
9 official business requires him to do so; now therefore

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

11 Section 1. Section 15102 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
12 amended to read as follows:

13 "Section 15102. Same: duties. It shall be the duty of the
14 Washington Representative, elected as provided in Section 15100 of
15 this Chapter, to establish and maintain an office headquarters in
16 the Nation's Capitol for the purpose of full-time representation for
17 the people of Guam at the United States Congress and with the various
18 agencies of the Federal government on matters of local application to
19 Guam including problems affecting Guam. He shall report in person
20 to the Legislature during that portion of each annual regular session
21 of the Guam Legislature which reconvenes on the second Monday of
22 June. He shall actively advocate at Washington, D.C. all programs
23 and policies duly adopted by the Guam Legislature."
