Introduced by <u>Committee on Rules</u> at the request of the Governor

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 840, PENAL CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO ARRESTS.

 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

 Section 1. Section 840 of the Penal Code of Guam is hereby

 amended to read as follows:

"Section 840. Arrests, when may be made. Without warrant, when. If the offense charged is a felony, the arrest may be made on any day, and at any time of the day or night. If it is a misdemeanor, the arrest cannot be made at night, unless:

1. Upon the direction of the magistrate endorsed upon the warrant, or

2. The offense is committed in the presence of the arresting officer, or

3. The arresting officer has reasonable grounds to believe that the person to be arrested has committed a misdemeanor and will not be apprehended unless immediately arrested or that personal or property damage may likely be done unless immediately arrested."
