AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 594 OF THE PENAL CODE OF GUAM
RELATING TO PUNISHMENT FOR THE OFFENSE OF MALICIOUS
MISCHIEF.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That
2 Section 594 of the Penal Code of Guam is hereby amended as follows:

3 "Section 594. Malicious mischief in general, defined. Every
4 person who maliciously injures or destroys any real or personal property, not
5 his own, in cases other than such as are specified in this Code, is guilty
6 of a misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment for not more than one year or
7 by fine of not more than \$1,000 or both.
