AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 594 OF THE PENAL CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO FUNISHMENT FOR THE OFFERISE OF MALICIOUS MISCHIEF.

Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That Section 594 of the Penal Code of Guam is hereby amended as follows:

"Section 594. Malicious mischief in general, defined. Every person who maliciously injures or destroys any real or personal property, not his own, in cases other than such as are specified in this Code, is guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by imprisonment for not more than one year or by fine of not more than 11,000 or both.
