AN ACT ADDING A NEW SECTION 653m TO CHAPTER 11 OF TITLE XY OF PART I OF THE PENAL CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO TELE-PHONE CALLS WITH INTENT TO ANNOY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That the following new Section 653m is added to Chapter 11 of Title XV of Part I of the Penal Code of Guam:

"Section 653m. Telephone calls with intent to annoy. (a)

Every person who with intent to annoy telephones another and addresses to or
about such other person any obscene language or addresses to such other person
any threat to inflict injury to the person or property of the person addressed
or any member of his family is guilty of a misdemeanor.

- "(b) Every person who makes a telephone call with intent to annoy another and without disclosing his true identity to the person answering the telephone is, whether or not conversation ensues from making the telephone call, guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed Fifty Dollars (\$50,00).
- "(c) Any offense committed by use of a telephone as here in set out may be deemed to have been committed at either the place at which the telephone call or calls were made or at the place where the telephone call or calls were received."
