AN ACT ADDING A NEW SECTION 4020 TO CHAPTER 1 OF TITLE
5 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO INTERDEPART-
MENTAL AND APPOINTMENTS AND TRANSFERS.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That the
2 following new Section 4020 is added to Chapter 1 of Title 5 of the Government
3 Code of Guam:

4 "Section 4020. Interdepartmental Transfers. Any employee in
5 the classified service of the Executive Branch of the government of Guam hold-
6 ing a government position may be appointed or transferred to a position in a
7 different department or agency requiring equivalent qualification for the one
8 held or to a higher position. Qualification and standards as established by
9 the Department of Labor and Personnel in cooperation with any department
10 authorized by existing statutory provisions to administer the personnel law
11 shall be honored and accepted. Any employee affected by this provision of the
12 law shall not have affected adversely his governmental service, retirement
13 credits, sick leave or annual leave, and other fringe benefits normally granted
14 to an employee of the government of Guam."
