AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 16015 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE
OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE RENEWAL OF BUSINESS LICENSES.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That
2 Section 16015 of the Government Code of Guam is amended to read as follows:

3 "Section 16015. Renewal. A licensee may renew his license at
4 the expiration thereof by the payment of the annual license fee and by filing
5 with the renewal application an affidavit (oath) and subject to the penalties of
6 perjury that he has continued to comply with all of the prerequisites and qua-
7 lifications provided by law, rules and regulations which were certified by the
8 proper departments of the government of Guam in the application for his origi-
9 nal license. The renewing licensee shall not be required to obtain the appro-
10 val of the government of Guam or any department or agency thereof regarding the
11 application of the Zoning Law of the territory of Guam to the licensee's busi-
12 ness premises provided that the licensed business is located upon the identical
13 premises upon which it was located on the date of the issuance of the previous
14 license.

15 "A licensee who fails to renew his license on or before the
16 thirtieth (30th) day of June of each year shall be assessed a penalty of one
17 dollar (\$1.00) per each calendar day he is delinquent, which penalty shall be-
18 come part of the renewal fee. Any licensee who fails to renew his license on
19 or before the thirty-first (31st) day of July shall be required to discontinue
20 his business until he renews the license or be subject to an injunction issued
21 by the Island Court and to prosecution under Section 16017. Such failure to
22 renew while continuing the operation of the business shall constitute refusal
23 and failure to obtain a license under the provisions of this Title."
