AN ACT TO ADD SUBCHAPTER F TO CHAPTER 9, TITLE 12, GOVERN-MENT CODE OF GUAM, TO GRANT ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIPS TO VALEDIC-TORIANS AND SALUTATORIANS OF GUAM HIGH SCHOOLS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subchapter F is hereby added to Chapter 9, Title 12, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"SUBCHAPTER F

Scholarships for Valedictorians and Salutatorians

Section 11821. Students Entitled to Scholarship: Amount of Scholarship. There are hereby established annual scholarships to the College of Guam, or to any accredited college or university in the United States to ininclude textbooks, tuition, reasonable clothing, room and board, other school fees, and costs of transportation if such college or university is without Guam, for a period of four years. Recipients of such Scholarships shall be the valedictorians and salutatorians of all high schools in each graduating class of the public and private high schools in Guam which have a total enrollment of not less than 100 students in the 9th to 12th grades now or hereafter established. To be eligible for the award of a scholarship granted under this subchapter, a student must be a U.S. citizen and a bona fide resident of Guam for a period of at least two years immediately preceding the date of the award thereof.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately and the valedictorians and salutatorians of the public and private high schools for the school year ending in June, 1966, shall be eligible for the scholarship awards
