AN ACT ADDING SECTION 226 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF
GUAM TO ESTABLISH A FARMERS APPRECIATION DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 226 is hereby added to the Government Code
of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 226. Farmers Appreciation Day. The last Saturday of
March in each year and the Sunday immediately following said Saturday shall be
known as Farmers Appreciation Days, and hereby are made a special holiday in
commemoration of the accomplishments of the farmers of Guam, the backbone of
our community. The Governor of Guam shall issue a proclamation calling upon the
people of Guam to observe such event and shall appoint a committee to plan and
make appropriate arrangements for the observance of said holiday."
