AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 23110.1 TO CHAPTER II, TITLE XXIV, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, REQUIRING THE INSTALLMENT OF SAFETY BELTS ON NEW PASSENGER VEHICLES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Section 23110.1 is hereby added to Chapter II,
3 Title XXIV, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

4 "Section 23110.1. Safety Belts on Passenger Vehicles.

5 (a) On or after January 1, 1967, no person shall sell any new passen-
6 gers vehicle, other than a motorcycle, manufactured after January 1,
7 1966, which is not equipped with anchors or other device meeting the
8 specifications established by the Department of Public Safety, to
9 which safety belts or safety harnesses may be attached and secured
10 for at least two passengers in the front seat.

11 Such anchors or other devices shall be capable of withstanding
12 a belt assembly load of 5,000 pounds.

13 (b) On or after January 1, 1967, no person shall sell or offer for
14 sale any new passenger vehicle, other than a motorcycle, which is not
15 equipped with at least two safety belts or safety belt-shoulder har-
16 ness combinations of a type approved by the Department of Public
17 Safety which are installed for the use of persons in the front seat
18 of the vehicle.

19 This section only applies to a retail sale of, or an offer to
20 sell at retail, a new passenger vehicle.

21 (c) Any safety belt or safety harness installed in a vehicle shall
22 be large enough to accommodate an adult person and designed and in-
23 stalled in such a manner as to prevent or materially reduce movement
24 of the person using the same in event of collision or upset of the
25 vehicle.

26 (d) The Department of Public Safety shall establish specifications
27 or requirements for approved-type safety belts. These requirements
28 shall not be lower than those established by Federal Specifications
29 used in the management of transportation equipment by the Bureau of

(e) No person shall sell, offer, or keep for sale any safety belts, safety harness, or attachments thereto for use in vehicle unless of a type which has been approved by the Department of Public Safety."
