


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

at the request of the Governor.

AN ACT TO ENACT A NEW SUBSECTION (n) TO SECTION 23100,
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO ACTUAL DEMONSTRATION
OF ABILITY TO EXERCISE ORDINARY AND REASONABLE CONTROL IN
THE OPERATION OF A MOTORCYCLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subsection (n) is hereby added to Section 23100, Govern-
ment Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"(n) After passing an examination as required under Subsection (g)
to include an actual demonstration of ability to exercise ordinary and reasonable
control in the operation of a motorcycle an applicant may have his operator's or
chauffer's permit endorsed by the Director of Public Safety, or his designee, authorizing
the applicant to operate a motorcycle on the highways of Guam. The Director of Public
Safety may in his discretion accept evidence of a military motorcycle permit in lieu
of this examination and endorsement. No person shall operate a motorcycle on the
highway without first complying with this section. Any person who operates a motor-
cycle in violation of this Title shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction
thereof shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or by fine
of not more than \$500.00, or both."
