AN ACT ADDING A NEW SECTION 1800L.5 TO THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE NON-APPLICATION OF THE
SUBDIVISION LAW OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM TO LAND WHICH
IS AN ASSET OF THE ESTATE OF A DECEDENT.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That the
2 following new Section 1800L.5 is added to the Government Code of Guam:

3 "Section 1800L.5. Decedents' estates. Chapter 5 of this Title
4 shall not apply to land which is an asset of the estate of a decedent, provided,
5 however, that, before the distribution of any such land by the court, the terri-
6 torial planner or Commission may enter his or its appearance and require street
7 and utility easements on said land to insure lot divisions consistent with the
8 general plan and with the provisions of Section 18400."
