AN ACT ADDING A NEW SECTION 18001.5 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE NON-APPLICATION OF THE SUBDIVISION LAW OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM TO LAND WHICH IS AN ASSET OF THE ESTATE OF A DECEDENT.

Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That the following new Section 18001.5 is added to the Government Code of Guam:

"Section 18001.5. Decedents' estates. Chapter 5 of this Title shall not apply to land which is an asset of the estate of a decedent, provided, however, that, before the distribution of any such land by the court, the territorial planner or Commission may enter his or its appearance and require street and utility easements on said land to insure lot divisions consistent with the general plan and with the provisions of Section 18400."
