



AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
INITIAL EXPENSES OF THE GUAM HOUSING AND  
URBAN RENEWAL AUTHORITY WITH RESPECT TO  
LOW RENT PUBLIC HOUSING AND URBAN RENEWAL  
PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in  
the unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$16,927 to the Guam Housing  
and Urban Renewal Authority for deposit in the Urban Renewal Housing Authority  
Revolving Fund, to initiate the low rent housing program for Guam and the urban renewal  
projects for Tumon and Sinajana; provided, however, that the amount of any expenditures  
from the sum herein appropriated which is hereafter reimbursed by the United States  
Government shall be returned to the General Fund by the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal  
Authority.

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
