






AN ACT TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 47061, 47062,
47063 AND 47064 TO CHAPTER I, TITLE XLIV,
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO
INFORMATION FURNISHED THE DEPARTMENT OF
COMMERCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 47061 is hereby added to the Government
Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 47061. Information as confidential.

Neither the Director nor any other officer or employee of
the Department of Commerce may -

(a) use the information furnished under the provisions
of this Chapter for any purpose other than the statistical
purposes for which it is supplied; or

(b) make any publication whereby the data furnished
by any particular establishment or individual under this
Chapter can be identified."

Section 2. Section 47062 is hereby added to the Government
Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 47062. Failure to answer questions; false
answers. Whoever, being the owner, official, agent, person in
charge, or assistant person in charge of any company, business,
institution, establishment, or organization of any nature
whatsoever, neglects or refuses, when requested by the
Director or other authorized officer or employee of the
Department of Commerce to answer completely and correctly
to the best of his knowledge all questions pertinent to the
duties of the Department of Commerce as set forth in Section

1 49060 of this Chapter, and relating to his company, business,
2 institution, establishment or other organization, or to
3 records or statistics in his official custody, contained in
4 any census or other schedule prepared and submitted to him
5 under authority of this Chapter, shall be fined not more
6 than \$500 or imprisoned not more than sixty days, or both;
7 and if he wilfully gives a false answer to any such question,
8 he shall be fined not more than \$1000 or imprisoned not more
9 than one year, or both."

10 Section 3. Section 47063 is hereby added to the Government
11 Code of Guam to read as follows:

12 "Section 47063. Wrongful disclosure of information.
13 Whoever, being an officer or employee of the Department of
14 Commerce, publishes or communicates, without the written
15 authority of the Director, any information coming into his
16 possession by reason of his employment under the provisions
17 of this Chapter shall be fined not more than \$1000 or
18 imprisoned not more than one year, or both."

19 Section 4. Section 47064 is hereby added to the Government
20 Code of Guam to read as follows:

21 "Section 47074. Promulgation of rules and regulations.
22 The Director of Commerce shall make and may alter, amend or
23 repeal rules and regulations as required to carry out the
24 purposes of this Chapter, which, after approval and
25 promulgation by the Governor as executive order, shall
26 have the force and effect of law; provided that such
27 rules and regulations, including the proposed forms
28 whereby the information and data sought by the Department
29 is given, may be made, altered, amended or repealed by
30 the Director of Commerce only after a public hearing
