AN ACT TO AMERIC SECTION 4213 OF THE COVERNMENT CODE OF GUAN RELATING TO THE REFUEN OF REFUEDED REFIREMENT CONTRIBUTIONS UPON RE-EMPLOYMENT.

BE IT EMACTED BY THE PROPER OF THIS THREITORY OF CHAR:

Section 1. Section 4213 of the Government Code of Coam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Bestien 4213. Befund on separation. Upon complete separation from service before a member shall have completed at least 20 years total service, the member shall be entitled to receive a refund of his total contributions, including regular interest, but no payment of interest shall be made in any case in which total mervice is less then one year.

any number who withdraws after having completed at least five years total service shall have the option of leaving his contributions in the flund and receiving a service retirement anmity upon attainment of the age of 60 years without choice of any of the optional survivors' hemefits hereinnfter described.

If such member has less than 20 years of total service, he may elect to receive his contributions, with regular interest, as hereinabove provided, in lieu of the service metirement annulty. If his total service is 20 years or more, the acceptance of such deferred retirement annuity payment beginning at the age of 60 years, chall be mandatory as to such member.

Any member receiving a refund of contributions shall thereby ipso facto forfeit, waive and relinquish all accrued rights and benefits in the system, including all credited and creditable service. The Board may, in its discretion regardless of cause, withhold payment of a refund for a period not to exceed one year after receipt of an application from a member.

Any member who has received a refund shall be considered a new member upon subsequent re-employment if such person qualifies for membership under the provision hereof. Such member shall have the right to make a repayment to the system of the amount or amounts previously received as refund, including regular interest from the dates of refund to the date of repayment. Upon the restoration of such refunds, as herein provided, such member shall have reinstated to his account all credited service represented by the refunds of which repayment has been made. Repayments of refunds by any member shall include all refunds received by a member prior to the date of his last withdrawal from service and shall be made in a single sum or in installments under rules prescribed by the Board, except that in the event of installment payment, the member seeking reinstatement of prior credited service may execute, under rules prescribed by the Board, a credit life insurance policy on his life wherein the fund is beneficiary for the grount still due to be repeid to the fund, the pressiums on such policy of insurance to be paid by the member and in the event of the member's death before the refund has been repeal without such eredit life insurance having been obtains , then the anuity payable to the survivor or survivors shall be reduced pro rate".

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
