




AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11102, CHAPTER 2,  
TITLE XII, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE  
TO COMPOSITION OF TERRITORIAL BOARD OF  
EDUCATION.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11102 of the Government Code of Guam is  
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 11102. Board. The board shall consist of seven  
5 members, all citizens of the United States of America and  
6 residents of Guam, who shall be appointed by the Governor with  
7 the advice and consent of the Legislature. There may be, in  
8 addition, advisors who shall be without vote. Advisory members  
9 shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the board."

10 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
