
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 4022 TO
THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING
TO THE REINSTATEMENT OF ACCUMULATED
SICK LEAVE TO EMPLOYEES RETURNING TO
GOVERNMENT OF GUAM EMPLOYMENT.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. A new Section 4022 is hereby added to the
3 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 4022. Reinstatement of Accumulated Sick
5 Leave. Any employee of the Government of Guam occupying
6 a permanent position who terminates such employment
7 voluntarily, who is drafted into the Armed Forces of
8 the United States or who voluntarily enlists in said
9 Armed Forces, who is re-employed by the Government of
10 Guam within three (3) years after the date of his
11 termination, in the cases of those who terminate
12 voluntarily or who are drafted, or within five (5)
13 years from date of termination in the case of those
14 who enlist in the Armed Forces, shall be entitled
15 to have all the sick leave he had accumulated and
16 not used as of the date of his termination reinstated
17 upon his re-employment to a permanent position."

18 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
