AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 4022 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO THE REINSTATEMENT OF ACCUMULATED SICK LEAVE TO EMPLOYEES RETURNING TO GOVERNMENT OF GUAM EMPLOYMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM: Section 1. A new Section 4022 is hereby added to the Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 4022. Reinstatement of Accumulated Sick Leave. Any employee of the Government of Guam occupying a permanent position who terminates such employment voluntarily, who is drafted into the Armed Forces of the United States or who voluntarily enlists in said Armed Forces, who is re-employed by the Government of Guam within three (3) years after the date of his termination, in the cases of those who terminate voluntarily or who are drafted, or within five (5) years from date of termination in the case of those who enlist in the Armed Forces, shall be entitled to have all the sick leave he had accumulated and not used as of the date of his termination reinstated upon his re-employment to a permanent position." Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
