AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23300 (1), CHAPTER 2, TITLE XXIV, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO THE EXPIRATION OF SECTION OF SECTION

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAR.

Section 1. Section 23100 (1) of Chapter 2, Title XXIV, Government Code of Guam, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(1) Every operator's or chouffour's license hereafter issued shall expire three years after the first anniversary of the date of birth of any applicant occurring after the date of lasuance. The anniversary of the date of birth of any applicant born on February twenty-minth shall, for the purposes of this section, during the years in which there is no February twenty-ninth, be considered as March first. Every such license shall be renewable for a like period within minety (90) days prior to its expiration. Any license that would otherwise expire on a Saturday or legal holiday shall be valid until the next business day. An applicant for renewal of a license shall make application therefor in the same manner as in the case of an original application for a license upon such form as may be required. The Director of Public Safety at his discretion may require an examination of the applicant as upon an original application. To the extent its facilities penalt, the Department of Public Safety shall, in the course of its investigation, check the record of the amplicant for convictions for traffic violations and traffic accidents, and may withhold or refuse certification of eligibility for a license or rememble of a license unless satisfied upon reasonable proof that the applicant can and will operate a motor vehicle safely."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
