AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23100 (1), CHAPTER 2, TITLE XXIV,  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO THE EXPIRATION OF  
OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 23100 (1) of Chapter 2, Title XXIV, Government Code of Guam, is  
3 hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "(1) Every operator's or chauffeur's license hereafter issued shall expire  
5 three years after the first anniversary of the date of birth of any applicant  
6 occurring after the date of issuance. The anniversary of the date of birth  
7 of any applicant born on February twenty-ninth shall, for the purposes of  
8 this section, during the years in which there is no February twenty-ninth, be  
9 considered as March first. Every such license shall be renewable for a like  
10 period within ninety (90) days prior to its expiration. Any license that  
11 would otherwise expire on a Saturday or legal holiday shall be valid until the  
12 next business day. An applicant for renewal of a license shall make application  
13 therefor in the same manner as in the case of an original application for a  
14 license upon such form as may be required. The Director of Public Safety at his  
15 discretion may require an examination of the applicant as upon an original  
16 application. To the extent its facilities permit, the Department of Public  
17 Safety shall, in the course of its investigation, check the record of the  
18 applicant for convictions for traffic violations and traffic accidents, and may  
19 withhold or refuse certification of eligibility for a license or renewal of a  
20 license unless satisfied upon reasonable proof that the applicant can and will  
21 operate a motor vehicle safely."

22 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.

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
