Public Law 9-32 Ninth Guam Legislature (Bill 1) March 10, 1967

AN ACT

An Act to amend Section 11837 of the Government Code of Guam to provide the waiver of tuition fees for the first two years of college at the College of Guam.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. Section 11837 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 11837. Fees and tuition. Fees and rate of tuition shall be fixed by the Board of Regents except that tuition rates for residents of Guam or members of the Armed Forces of the United States shall be fifty (50) per cent of those charged nonresidents, and except that no tuition fees will be charged to residents of Guam, who have resided on Guam at least two (2) years prior to admission, for attendance during the freshman and sophomore years at the College."

Section 2. This Act shall take effect July 1, 1967.

Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
