Public Law 9-35 Ninth Guam Legislature (Bill 121) March 13, 1967

## AN ACT

An Act to amend Section 1300 of the Government Code of Guam relating to the Legislative Audit.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. Section 1300 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1300. Legislative Audit. Notwith-standing any other provision of law the Legislature shall, annually, audit or cause an audit to be made of all government of Guam accounts and financial transactions, by an independent audit firm or organization, which audit shall be under the direction and supervision of the Legislature. In the event that the United States General Accounting Office makes an audit of Government of Guam accounts and financial transactions, the Legislature need not cause an independent audit of its own to be made for that particular fiscal year so audited by the United States Accounting Office."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
