AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 15105 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO THE FILLING OF VACANCIES IN THE POST OF WASHINGTON REPRESENTATIVE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 15105 is hereby added to the Government

Code of Guam to read as follows:

"Section 15105. Same. Vacancies. In the event
of a vacancy in the position of Washington Representative, caused by the death, resignation, or
incapacity of the incumbent, the Governor of Guam
shall, with the advice and consent of the Legislature,
appoint from among those qualified for such position,
a person to serve until the next regular general
election for members of the Guam Legislature, and
until his successor has been qualified or the
Congress of the United States provides for a
Resident Commissioner or Delegate or Territorial
Deputy for Guam, at which next regular general
election, a special election shall behable to
fill the vacancy in such position."
Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
