

AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11821 TO TITLE XII, CHAPTER 9, SUBCHAPTER E, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, TO PERMIT OFF-ISLAND SCHOLARSHIPS AND STUDENT LOANS ONLY IF STUDIES ARE NOT AVAILABLE IN GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PROPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAN:

Section 1. Section 11821 is hereby added to Chapter 9, Title 12, Subchapter E, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

"Section 11821. Government of Guam Scholarships and Student Loans other than those provided in Sections 11821 and 11803 shall be authorized for institutions outside the territory of Guam only upon the certification by the Board that the contemplated course of study is not available within the territory of Guam; provided, however, that for the purpose of this section the Board shall not certify the availability of pre-medicine, pre-dentistry, and pre-law courses at the College of Guam."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
