AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 11821 TO TITLE XII, CHAPTER
9, SUBCHAPTER E, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, TO PERMIT
OFF-ISLAND SCHOLARSHIPS AND STUDENT LOANS ONLY IF
STUDIES ARE NOT AVAILABLE IN GUAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11821 is hereby added to Chapter 9, Title
3 12, Subchapter E, Government Code of Guam, to read as follows:

4 "Section 11821. Government of Guam Scholarships and
5 Student Loans other than those provided in Sections 11821
6 and 11803 shall be authorized for institutions outside the
7 territory of Guam only upon the certification by the Board
8 that the contemplated course of study is not available within
9 the territory of Guam; provided, however, that for the pur-
10 pose of this section the Board shall not certify the availability
11 of pre-medicine, pre-dentistry, and pre-law courses at the
12 College of Guam."

13 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
