



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CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 21005 AND 21103 OF THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO LOWER THE RATE FOR  
WATER USED FOR WATERING LIVESTOCK AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES AND TO ADD A NEW SECTION 23354.1 TO THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO ESTABLISH AN ABANDONED  
VEHICLE FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 21005 of the Government Code of Guam is  
hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 21005. ~~Same:~~ public hearings. Before adopting  
any schedule increasing water, power or telephone rates, the  
Board shall hold at least one public hearing thereon, notice of  
the time and place of which shall be given by at least one  
publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Guam, at  
least ten days before the date of said hearing. The Board,  
with the unanimous consent of its members, may subpoena wit-  
nesses, books and records. Schedules or portions of schedules  
reducing rates may be adopted without public hearing."

Section 2. Section 21103 of the Government Code of Guam is  
hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 21103. <sup>to</sup> Functions. The functions of the Board  
shall be: to formulate, establish and publish, and from time to  
time to review and where necessary revise, subject to the ap-  
proval of the Governor by Executive Order, fair and reasonable  
schedules, and from time to time, of public utility rates in-  
cluding all related service, meter and other applicable charges  
for all public utility services furnished by the Government of  
Guam. Such schedules may provide for separate residential, com-  
mercial, industrial or other standardized categories of rates,  
and such schedules shall provide that the rate charged for

1 water utilized by bona fide farmers, as certified by the  
2 Department of Agriculture, for irrigation purposes shall be  
3 not more than twenty-five cents (\$.25) per thousand gallons  
4 and that the rate charged for such farmers for watering  
5 their livestock, including but not limited to poultry, pigs  
6 and cattle, shall also be not more than thirty cents (\$.30)  
7 per thousand gallons. The Board shall annually, and may in  
8 its discretion more often upon complaint or upon its own  
9 motion, review and recommend revision of such schedules of  
10 rates and related charges as may at any time be in effect.

11 Section 3. A new Section 23354.1 is hereby added to the  
12 Government Code of Guam to read as follows:

13 "Section 23354.1. (a) There is hereby established within  
14 the Treasury of Guam a fund to be known as the 'Abandoned  
15 Vehicle Fund' which shall be maintained separate and apart  
16 from any other funds of the Government of Guam and independent  
17 records and accounts shall be maintained in connection there-  
18 with. Money in the Abandoned Vehicle Fund shall be used for  
19 the purpose of removing and disposing of all abandoned vehi-  
20 cles found upon public and private property in Guam upon  
21 appropriation by the Legislature of Guam.

22 (b) In addition to all other fees imposed by law an  
23 additional \$1.00 annual fee is imposed upon any vehicle sub-  
24 ject to registration under this title which shall be deposited  
25 in the Treasury of Guam to the credit of the Abandoned  
26 Vehicle Fund. This fee shall be collected at the same time  
27 and in the same manner as the annual license and registration  
28 fee provided for in this title."

29 Section 4. This Act is an urgency measure.
