AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 4207.7 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO PERMIT
EMPLOYEES WHO TAKE LEAVE WITHOUT PAY
OR TERMINATE IN ORDER TO FURTHER THEIR
EDUCATION TO OBTAIN RETIREMENT CREDIT
FOR SUCH TIME SPENT FOR SUCH PURPOSE.

1 IT IS ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 4207.7 is hereby added to the Government
3 Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 4207.7. Credit for Educational Training Service.

5 Any person who is employed by the Government of Guam who takes
6 leave of absence without pay or terminates from such employment
7 in order to further his education may, when returning to employ-
8 ment with the Government of Guam, claim retirement credit for
9 such time so spent in furthering his education by paying to
10 the fund the contributions which he would have paid had such
11 time so spent on education not been excluded by virtue of his
12 leave of absence without pay or termination, together with
13 regular interest thereon, from the date on which such contribu-
14 tions would have been made, had such time so spent not been
15 excluded, to the date of actual payment; provided, however,
16 that this section shall apply only to those persons who resume
17 employment in the Government of Guam within two (2) years after
18 completing their studies."

19 Section 2. This Act shall take effect retroactively as of May
20 1, 1961.

21 Section 3. This Act is an urgency measure.
