



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT

An Act to renumber Section 14240 of the Government Code of Guam, to be Section 47140 and to amend the same with respect to reimbursement for services of customs and quarantine officers of the Government of Guam.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. Section 14240 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby renumbered Section 47140 of said Code and amended to read as follows:

*Section 47140. Charges for services of customs and quarantine officers. All air and sea carriers and other persons whose operations require the services of customs and quarantine officers of the Government of Guam shall be charged for said services as are rendered by such officers on Sundays, holidays, or between the hours of 5 P.M. of any day and 8 A.M. of the following day as follows: for the first hour of such services, the hourly wage rate of whichever officer is engaged in the services, plus twenty-five per cent (25%) thereof as reimbursement for administrative overhead and overtime; for between one (1) hour and three (3) hours of such services, the hourly wage rate for three (3) hours service by whichever officer is performing such service, plus twenty-five per cent (25%) thereof for administrative overhead and overtime; for any hour or fraction thereof over three (3) hours, the hourly wage rate of whichever officer performs such services, plus twenty-five per cent (25%) thereof

for administrative overhead. Any sum received by the Government of Guam for such overtime work shall be reimbursed to the employee who has rendered such service, regardless of his pay range, less the twenty-five per cent (25%) administrative overhead and overtime charge to be retained by the Government of Guam.

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
