AE ACT TO EXECUMBER SECTION 11580 OF THE GOVERNMENT GODE OF GUAR TO BE RESTION 11881, AND TO ADD A RES SECTION 11880 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAR TO ASSESORIZE SCHOOL TRACHERS IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS OF GUAR WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF GUAR TO ATTEND THE COLLEGE OF GUAR WEREE AN IS-SERVICE TRAINING PROGRAM.

BE IT MEASTED BY THE PROPIL OF THE TERRITORY OF SUAM: Section 1. Section 11880 of the Soverment Code of Gusz is

hereby remembered Section 11881.

Section 2. A new Section 11880 is herely added to the Government Code of Gues to read as follows:

> "Section 11880. In-Service Training for Resident Teachers. Any non-opatrast teacher or professional educator employed by the Department of Dimostics in a permanent position who is a bons file recident of the territory of Owen who lacks not more than two (2) years or their equivalent in requirements for a baccaleureste degree in education shall be entitled to emrollment at the College of Cuam for the purpose of completing work toward such degree as an in-service training program, whereby he continues to receive his regular salary from the department, including all scheduled pay increases, so long as he maintains passing work at the College and so long as a program leading to the issuance of a baccalaureate degree in education is pursued; provided, however, that no person shall participate in such in-service program in excess of two (2) years of their equivalent. In addition, every person who participates in such progress shall be obligated to work for the Covernment of Guen for a period of two years for each year of training received, failing which he shall be liable to repay the cost to the government of his training." Section 2. This Act is an urganay measure.
