


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO RENUMBER SECTION 11880 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO BE SECTION 11881, AND TO ADD A NEW
SECTION 11880 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO
AUTHORIZE SCHOOL TEACHERS IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS
OF GUAM WHO ARE RESIDENTS OF GUAM TO ATTEND THE
COLLEGE OF GUAM UNDER AN IN-SERVICE TRAINING PROGRAM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 11880 of the Government Code of Guam is
3 hereby renumbered Section 11881.

4 Section 2. A new Section 11880 is hereby added to the Government
5 Code of Guam to read as follows:

6 "Section 11880. In-Service Training for Resident Teachers.

7 Any non-~~certificat~~ teacher or professional educator employed by
8 the Department of Education in a permanent position who is a
9 bona fide resident of the territory of Guam who lacks not
10 more than two (2) years or their equivalent in requirements
11 for a baccalaureate degree in education shall be entitled
12 to enrollment at the College of Guam for the purpose of
13 completing work toward such degree as an in-service training
14 program, whereby he continues to receive his regular salary
15 from the department, including all scheduled pay increases,
16 so long as he maintains passing work at the College and so
17 long as a program leading to the issuance of a baccalaureate
18 degree in education is pursued; provided, however, that no
19 person shall participate in such in-service program in excess
20 of two (2) years or their equivalent. In addition, every person
21 who participates in such program shall be obligated to work for
22 the Government of Guam for a period of two years for each year
23 of training received, failing which he shall be liable to repay
24 the cost to the government of his training."

25 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
