AN ACT

An Act to amend Section 8904 of the Government Code of Guam to remove the fee requirement for registration of firearms.

*Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:*

Section 1. Section 8904 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 8904. Fees. Permanent registration: The registration of any firearm as well as any permit issued pursuant to Section 8907, and firearms covered by Section 8902, shall be permanent. The fee for each registration or permit shall be one dollar (\$1.00) and shall be paid by the applicant to the Department of Finance before the certificate of registration or permit may be issued."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure
