AN ACT TO CHANGE THE STATUS OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMERCIAL PORT OF GUAM FROM "TEMPORARY" TO "PERMANENT".

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. The employment status of no less than ten (10) stevedore gangs (fourteen (14) men per gang) now classified as temporary employees of the Commercial Fort of Guam shall be converted as of July 1, 1967 from "temporary" to "permanent", subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Initial appointment shall be probationary, in accordance with the Fersonnel Rules and Regulations;
- (b) Such employees shall retain their current class titles, subject to a classification study;
- (c) For purposes of leave and retirement benefits, such employees shall be credited with their service prior to July 1, 1967.
