





AN ACT TO CHANGE THE STATUS OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE  
COMMERCIAL PORT OF GUAM FROM "TEMPORARY" TO "PERMANENT".

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. The employment status of no less than ten (10) stevedore gangs  
3 (fourteen (14) men per gang) now classified as temporary employees of the Commercial  
4 Port of Guam shall be converted as of July 1, 1967 from "temporary" to "permanent",  
5 subject to the following conditions:

6 (a) Initial appointment shall be probationary, in accordance with the  
7 Personnel Rules and Regulations;

8 (b) Such employees shall retain their current class titles, subject to a  
9 classification study;

10 (c) For purposes of leave and retirement benefits, such employees shall  
11 be credited with their service prior to July 1, 1967.
