There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) to the Office of the Governor to be used as a contingency fund to supplement during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 the operational budget of any department or agency of the Government of Guam.

Section 3. Any grant received from the United States Government as General Fund revenue, is authorized to be expended for the purpose, or purposes, for which the grant is made.
