AN ACT

An Act making an appropriation for the operation of the Executive, Judicial and Legislative branches of the Government of Guam for fiscal year ending June 30, 1968, and for the operation of the Office of Washington Representative for the calendar year ending December 31, 1967.

Be it enacted by the People of the Territory of Guam:

Section 1. The following sums are hereby appropriated, from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968, for the purposes set forth in the topic headings and item entries:

Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) to the Office of the Governor to be used as a contingency fund to supplement during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1968 the operational budget of any department or agency of the Government of Guam.

Section 3. Any grant received from the United States Government as General Fund revenue, is authorized to be expended for the purpose, or purposes, for which the grant is made.
