AN ACT TO ADD SECTION 8901.1 TO CHAPTER 10,  
TITLE IX, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE  
TO ACQUISITION AND POSSESSION OF FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 8901.1, Government Code of Guam is hereby enacted to read as follows:

"Section 8901.1. Permits to acquire.

(a) No person shall acquire the ownership of a firearm of any description, whether usable or unusable, either by purchase, gift, inheritance or in any other manner, until he has first procured a permit to acquire such firearm from the Director of Public Safety. Further, no person shall use or have in his possession any such firearm which is owned by another, whether registered or unregistered and irrespective of whether or not such use or possession is with the consent of the owner, without a permit from the Director of Public Safety.

No person acquiring ownership of a firearm under the provisions of this section shall register the same as provided in Section 8901.

(b) No person shall sell, give, loan or deliver any firearm into the possession of one not holding a permit issued under this section."
