AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (N) OF SECTION 23100, GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO BE MONSTRATION OF ABILLITY TO EXERCISE CONTROL IN THE OPERATION OF A MOTORCYCLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAR.

WHILE DAY TO SE

Section 1. Subsection (n) of Section 23100, Government Code of Guan, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(n) After passing an examination as required under Subsection (g) to include an actual demonstration of ability to exercise ordinary and reasonable control in the operation of a motorcycle an applicant may have his operator's or chauffeur's permit endorsed by the Director of Public Safety, or his designed, authorizing the applicant to operate a motorcycle on the highways of Guan. The Director of Public Safety may in his discretion accept evidence of a military motorcycle permit in lieu of this examination and endorsement. No person shall operate a motorcycle on the highway without first complying with this section. Any person who operates a motorcycle in violation of this Title shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or by fine of not more than \$250,00, or both."
