AN ACT TO ADD A NEW TITLE LYI TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAN RELATIVE TO HOTEL CORPORATION.

BE IT EMACTED BY THE PROPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Title EVI is hereby added to the Soverment Code of Guam to reed as follows:

PRITLE INI

Hotel Corporation

Section 53650. Adequate hotel accommodations, with related facilities and services, being essential to the sound development of Guam and particularly to the development of Guam's tourist potential, the provision of such accommodations, facilities, and services is declared to be a public purpose.

Section 53651. There is hereby created a public corporation, the name of which is "Guam Botel Corporation," which is a separate entity with capacity to mis and be misd as such. The Corporation is decided to be a resident of Guam and shall maintain its principal offices in Guam.

Seption 53652. The purposes for which the Corporation is areated are the construction, development, promotion, and operation of hotels, with incidental and related facilities and services, for the adequate accomplation of tourists and other visitors in Owen.

Southern 19655. Encept as otherwise provided by law, the Corporation is mathorized and empowered to do all things necessary or appropriate to the purposes for which it is evented.

Section 53654. Upon request by the Board of Directors, the Governor is mathemised to make available to the Corporation, by male, lease, or otherwise, tracts of government-pened land multable for the Corporation's purposes. If the government does not oun tracts suitable for much purposes, the Sovernment is muthorized to negotiate with private landowners provided that funds must first be appropriated for such acquisition.

Section 55655. There is muthorised to be appropriated to the Corporation from time to time such sums as may be mecessary to enable the Corporation to accomplish its purposes.

Section 55656. The Corporation is assept from texation, but all met profite shall be paid assembly into the general fund of the government, except only such some as are necessary for operating expenses, debt liquidation, and capital improvements.

Section 53657. All debts incurred by the Corporation for whatever purpose are debts of the Corporation only and not of the government.

Section 53658. All duties and powers of management of the Corporation are vested in a Board of Directors, consisting of the Covernor, as Chalman, the Secretary of Suam as Vice Chalman, and eight additional Directors appointed by the Covernor. The appointed Directors shall hold office for terms of one year unless sooner removed by the Covernor. The Directors shall serve without compensation.

Section 53659. The Sovermor may appoint such other officers as the Board does necessary for the proper conduct of the Corporation's business including and upon such terms as it doess appropriate, a general manager, who will be charged with the executive management of the Corporation's affairs.

Section 53660. The Board, in its discretion, may make contracts with regutable management companies for the operation of the Corporation's hotels and other facilities, and with the consent of the legislature lease or sell said hotels or other facilities.

mostion 53661. Employees of the Corporation, who shall be within the elassified service of the Soverment of Suom, shall be eligible for retirement, worksen's compensation, and hospitalization insurance in the masser and to the some extent as are employees of the government."

Section 2. This Act shall take effect Jammary 2, 1968, but only in the event that no privately-owned hotel company possessing a qualifying certificate issued pursuant to the provisions of Title LIV of the Government Doie of Guam has commanded construction of its hotel facilities.
