

AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION 9500.15(a), SUB-
CHAPTER A, CHAPTER 6, TITLE I, GOVERNMENT CODE
OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO ABATEMENT OF PUBLIC NUISANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Subsection 9500.15(a) of the Government Code of Guam is
hereby amended to read as follows:

"(a) The Director, the Director of Public Works and the
Director of Public Safety, or their authorized representatives,
are directed and authorized to make inspections of all private
grounds and buildings in order to determine the existence of
any public nuisance defined in Part III of Division Fourth,
Civil Code of Guam."
