AN ACT ADDING A NEW SECTION 9121 TO THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM RELATIVE TO SUPPLYING FREE DENTAL CARE TO CHILDREN ATTENDING THE FIRST TO EIGHTH GRADES OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS IN GUAM AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR SUPPLYING SUCH FREE DENTAL CARE.

1 Be it enacted by the People of the territory of Guam, That the  
2 following new Section 9121 is added to Sub-chapter c of Chapter 2 of Title  
3 I of the Government Code of Guam:

4 "Section 9121. Free Dental Care. The division of Public  
5 Welfare shall supply free dental care to all children attending the first  
6 to eighth grades of Public and Private Schools in Guam. Such dental  
7 services shall be limited to prophylaxis and emergency extractions. All  
8 other dental services may be rendered if personnel and materials are avail-  
9 able."

10 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from any available  
11 funds in the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of Fifty  
12 Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) for the employment of dentists and the payment  
13 of all other expenses incident to supplying free dental care to children  
14 attending the first to eighth grades of public and private schools in Guam.
