

AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 647 OF THE PROBATE
CODE OF GUAM RELATING TO SETTLEMENT OF CERTAIN
ESTATES WITHOUT LEGAL PROCEEDINGS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 647 of the Probate Code of Guam is hereby amended
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 647. Settlement of certain estates without legal
5 proceedings. Whenever all the heirs of a person are of lawful age
6 and legal capacity and there are no debts due from the estate, or
7 all of the debts have been paid, the estate includes no real property
8 and the gross value thereof does not exceed Five Thousand Dollars
9 (\$5,000), the heirs may, by agreement duly executed in writing by all
10 of them and not otherwise, apportion and divide the estate among
11 themselves, as they may see fit, without proceedings in court."

12 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
