



CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 400 OF THE CIVIL CODE
OF GUAM TO CORRECT THE DESIGNATION OF THE COURT
HAVING JURISDICTION OVER THE DISSOLUTION OF
CORPORATIONS.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 400 of the Civil Code of Guam is hereby amended
3 to read as follows:

4 "Section 400. Dissolution voluntary. Application to Island
5 Court. A corporation may be dissolved at any time by the Island
6 Court upon the voluntary application of a majority of the members
7 or of the stockholders holding at least two-thirds of all shares of
8 stock issued or subscribed."

9 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
