AN ACT TO AMEND SUBSECTION (d) OF SECTION 4233 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAN TO PROVIDE THAT RETIREMENT CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE SMALL BE MADE ON A BI-MEEKLY BASIS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUARE

Section 1. Subsection (d) of Section 4233 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(d) In the case of any person who shall be a member of the Legislature on January 1, 1966 or who shall thereafter become such a member the annual average compensation of such person for the purposes of this chapter shall be considered as Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000) and the amount of contribution required of such person for the purposes of section 4218 of this title shall be six percent (6%) thereof to be deducted from the bi-weekly salary payments of those members of the Legislature serving therein, and otherwise to be made annually by those members me longer serving in the Legislature."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
