AN ACT TO AMEND SUB-PARAGRAPH (a) OF SECTION 23102 OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO THE SUSPENSION OF DRIVERS' LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUARE

Section 1. Sub-paragraph (a) of Section 23102 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 23102. Same: suspension and revocation. (a) Whenever any person is convicted of a violation of any provision of this title relating to the speed of webicles or of reckless driving, the court may, unless this title makes mandatory a revocation of such license by the Director of Public Safety, suspend the license of such person for a period of not to exceed thirty days upon first conviction, for a period of not to exceed sixty days upon a second conviction, for a period of not to exceed six manths upon a third or any subsequent conviction."

Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
