

AN ACT TO AMEND SUB-PARAGRAPH (a) OF SECTION 23102 OF THE  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO THE SUSPENSION OF  
DRIVERS' LICENSES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Sub-paragraph (a) of Section 23102 of the Government Code of Guam  
3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 23102. Same: suspension and revocation. (a) Whenever  
5 any person is convicted of a violation of any provision of this title  
6 relating to the speed of vehicles or of reckless driving, the court may,  
7 unless this title makes mandatory a revocation of such license by the  
8 Director of Public Safety, suspend the license of such person for a period  
9 of not to exceed thirty days upon first conviction, for a period of not to  
10 exceed sixty days upon a second conviction, for a period of not to exceed  
11 six months upon a third or any subsequent conviction."

12 Section 2. This Act is an urgency measure.
