
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO THE GOVERNOR

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 4210 OF THE GOVERNMENT
CODE OF GUAM TO PERMIT VOLUNTARY RETIREMENT AFTER
TWENTY (20) YEARS OF SERVICE OF THE GOVERNMENT OF
GUAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 4210 of the Government Code of Guam is hereby
amended to read as follows:

"Section 4210. Retirement. Any member may retire on
a service retirement annuity, upon his written application
to the Board, on the first day of the calendar month occurring
not less than 30 days or more than 90 days subsequent to the
execution and filing of such application, provided, however,
that such member shall have attained at least 60 years of
age or 55 years in the case of a member of the uniformed
personnel and shall have completed at least 10 years of
total service.

Any employee who has completed 30 years of service may
retire and shall be entitled to full retirement annuity.

Any employee or member, whether active or inactive, at
his option may retire after twenty (20) years of service
regardless of age. The retirement annuity for any employee
or member described in this paragraph shall be reduced
one-quarter of one per cent for each month such employee or
member is under age 60, from the amount determined for such
employee or member as hereinafter provided."

Section 2. This act is the urgent necessity.
