AN AGT TO AMEND CHAPTER 1, TITLE LIV, GOVERNMENT COME OF GUAM, RELATIVE TO GUAM ROGHONIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY.

HE IT ERACTED BY THE PROPIE OF THE TERRITORY OF SUAN:

Section 1. The following sections are hereby added to Chapter 1, Title LIV, Government Gode of Guam, to read as follows:

"Section 53596. Agricultural Development Fund. There is hereby established a special fund called the Agricultural Development Fund, hereinefter referred to as the 'Fund', which shall be maintained separate and apart from any other funds of the Guam Rosmanic Development Authority, and independent records and appearate shall be maintained in connection therewith.

Section 53597. Same: Source of Manies. The Fund shall consist of all memies appropriated by the Soverment of Suan or received from the United States Soverment or any agency thereof, or from any other source for the administration of this Act, or from any person or organization as compensation for services rendered or facilities supplied; amounts received pursuant to any surety band or insurance pelicy or from other sources for lorses sustained by the Fund or by reason of damage to equipment or supplies purchased with manies from the Fund; and all proceeds reclical from the sale or other disposition of any equipment or supplies purchased with manies from the Fund.

The Fund are to be used by the Susa Semanic Development Authority as part of a joint progress with the Department of Agriculture to aid in the development and/or submidistation of pork and beef production, agricultural products processing plants and equipment lance. This development will be shally on the basis of a private

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entemprise, and government land will be used only when it is readily available and suitable. Privately samed land will be utilized for the most part.

"Section 55999. Procedure. The program will proceed in two directions:

(a) Direct loans to individuals as approved by the Department of Agriculture.

(b) The organization of separate agricultural corporations to be jointly managed by the Guam Rosmomic Development Authority and the Department of Agriculture.

"Section 53500. Responsibilities. It shall be the responsibility of the Suam Reconsule Development Authority to (a) provide the needed funds, (b) provide financial and business management, (c) organize and direct marketing activities. It shall be the responsibility of the Repartment of Agriculture to (a) select and evaluate land when applicable, (b) approve and/or select the agricultural products involved, (c) exercise operating management control, (d) smercise scattnuing technical surveillance of each project.

"Section 57601. The of Pands. Pands will be advanced to whatever entity is involved for the purpose of purchasing begs, cattle, supplies, feed, etc., all related to beg or beef production; lessing and purchasing of equipment; establishing and developing agricultural products processing plants and the lessing of land when applicable to the development of pork and beef production or agricultural products processing plants. Collateral ascurity will be obtained, if possible. Pands so advanced will be on the basis of an interest change of three (30) percent par armum. In some instances finds advanced will be on a continuing and revolving basis, until such these as the project is self-supporting.

"Section 53602. Annual Reports. An annual report shall be
made jointly by the Guam Economic Development Authority and the
Department of Agriculture to the Governor and the Legislature,
reporting upon the progress made and containing a detailed financial
analysis.

"Section 53603. Construction. This Act shall be liberally
construed to accomplish its purpose of aiding in the development
